**AEDC releases Pointe Sunshine megasite national marketing presentation**

**Animated presentation with comprehensive info on site to be marketed nationally to site consultants including Corenet conference next week in San Diego with State and Chamber officials**

**(Sorrento, LA- April 29, 2008)**- The Ascension Economic Development Corporation (AEDC) has developed a state of the art marketing presentation that will be used to professionally market the 1,000 acre Pointe Sunshine deepwater megasite located just outside of Donaldsonville to national site selection consultants and real estate executives.

AEDC officials will be promoting the site next week at the Corenet Global meeting in San Diego. AEDC staff will be attending the Corenet meeting in conjunction with Louisiana Economic Development Secretary Stephen Moret and officials with the Baton Rouge Area Chamber and other Louisiana economic development professionals. The animated presentation highlights key facts and GIS maps on the site including utility, zoning, waterway, and transportation information which was obtained from engineering reports on the property including a Phase I analysis, wetlands determination, archeological and cultural analysis, and a utility analysis with links from the presentation to the actual engineering reports on line.
